Dear Hon. Scott S. Harris, Clerk of the U.S. Supreme Court,

I like to formally request that when you file my “PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI”, that it be put on the online docket system and the documents filed as pdf files online, as my family likes to check PACER.gov to watch my federal case(s). So I humbly and respectfully ask that my first Petition for a Writ of Certiorari, and the appendix be filed on the Supreme Court public website docket system. That way my family can confirm that it was filed correctly and that it was put in. I also ask that the entire appendix be placed on your website's docket system, like the others that were placed online. A few entries of the appendix record are of filings in the lower court that mention important terms such as “fraud upon the court” and proof of the frauds that were perpetuated upon the court. It is something the general public is learning about since the frauds upon the FISA Court in the cases dealing with Flynn, Michael Cohen, and others including Roger Stone. This case holds a nationwide issue of frauds upon the court being discovered and when a judge refuses to act upon those motions, then the court does not have the ability to prove it's own jurisdiction and thus the entire case is tainted in fraud and cannot be substantiated, it isn't sound judgments but judgments in fiat. It is important and pertinent that the entire appendix and the petition are both entirely uploaded to the Supreme Court website's docket system because of the severity and importance of the issues throughout the

appendix and the petition.

Also I hope it is okay for the justices that the ten copies that are bound is using combs. I asked OfficeMax to produce ten booklets of the petition and appendix altogether and they would only bind them in a spiral binding or comb. I heard that spiral binding is not allowed, and they would not bind the book by any other method, so I had no choice but for the ten copies to use comb binding.

The original petition and appendix are not bound except by binder clip because I understand that you have to scan in the original to be made electronically available. The ten copies are bound by comb because it was the only method of bindings that OfficeMax would make the books for the Supreme Court because it was 82 pages total with the 38 page Petition but 44 pages of appendix including index table of the appendix contents. I had already paid \$123.00 out of my limited SSI disability money to pay for those 10x books. So I beg of you that this be sufficient under the rules. My only choices OfficeMax would give me is spiral binding or comb binding. So I chose comb binding as that may be okay and I ask that it be okay since I had no other option at OfficeMax because any books over a certain number of pages cannot be stapled into a booklet. This is my first time filing a case with the U.S. Supreme Court. I ask that it be okay with the books/booklets as they are. If I had to redo it, it would cost me over \$100 again to redo it and I don't know which store would accept anything different with the CoronaVirus/Covid-19 crisis.

I am including in the Priority Mail Express box tracking no. EL-334898775 US the following:

1. Original Petition for a Writ of Certiorari (38 pages) with signature, Appendix (44 pages) including 2 page index of it's contents.
2. Ten (10x) books of the copy of the original Petition (38 pages) with signature, Appendix (44 pages), comb binding.
3. Original Certificate of Compliance (1 page)
4. Original Affidavit of Service + proof of service attached (4 pages + attached evidence which is 7 pages).
5. Original In Forma Pauperis Motion which is 4 pages + 5 page

- evidence (9 pages)
6. Ten (10x) copies of In Forma Pauperis Motion which is 4 pages + 5 page evidence (9 pages)
