Hey Clerk

I am Roberta Hill, Brian's mother. I am filing this EMERGENCY MOTION(s) for substitute counsel or for my son to proceed pro se through VACES on Brian's behalf due to his federal probation conditions where he is not allowed to use the internet. He is having me file this pleading in his stead, his emergency motion for new lawyer or proceed pro se. My son is having me to serve the respondent counsel through email as it is an EMERGENCY motion and Brian is also mailing them a copy through certified mail and the certificate of service is in the 11 and 12 page of 19 page of the PDF file of this filing.

Brian told me he is upset about his petitions for appeal being removed from the ACMS-CAV database when I shown him the status update from there and we saw that both was removed because of a corrupt unethical compromised lawyer who won't even talk to him because of a situation where the lawyer is likely being threatened or pressured or maybe even blackmailed.
